Of the more than one million Americans living with HIV/AIDS today, nearly half are Black. An estimated one in five of those living with HIV does not know they are infected. AIDS claims the lives of more Black Americans than any other racial or ethnic group. Early diagnosis and treatment saves lives. Testing is faster and easier than ever. Ask about rapid oral HIV tests.
