# Bay Area Employment Survey

November 2005

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## Methodology

The *Bay Area Employment Survey* is a joint project of the *San Jose Mercury News* and the Henry J. Kaiser Family Foundation. Representatives of the two organizations worked together to develop the survey questionnaire and analyze the results. The Kaiser Family Foundation paid for the survey-related expenses, and each organization bears sole responsibility for the work that appears under its name.

The survey was conducted by telephone from August 2 to September 11, 2005 among 1,721 adults age 18-64 years, who were selected at random. All respondents live in the Bay Area of California, which was defined as Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, San Francisco, Santa Clara, and San Mateo counties. Fieldwork was done by telephone by International Communications Research (ICR) of Media, PA in English, Spanish and Asian dialects.

The study employed an RDD sampling, screening for oversamples of unemployed residents, underemployed and problem employed residents.

The survey's margin of sampling error is +/- 3 percentage points overall. The sample size and margin of sampling error for each of these groups are shown in the table below.

Note: (1) Sampling error may be larger for other subgroups and sampling error is only one of many potential sources of error in this or any other public opinion poll. (2) Table percentages may not add to 100% due to rounding. (3) Data is not available for subgroups with fewer than 100 respondents. This is denoted with an "NA" throughout the topline.

### Worker Group Definitions:

**Unemployed** – adults ages 18-64 who are currently unemployed and looking for work

**Underemployed** – adults ages 18-64 who are employed part-time, but say they are presently looking for full-time work or currently employed adults who say they have been employed for a salary or wage significantly greater than their present salary or have been employed in a job that required significantly more job responsibilities or a higher educational degree than their current job. Additionally, to fall into this category, the latter group must agree that the following statement describes them well, "I have taken a job for a significantly lower salary or way, or requiring fewer skills than jobs I've had in the past because it was the best option I could get given the job situation in the Bay Area. However, I would prefer to be in a better job".

**Problem employed** – adults ages 18-64 who do not meet the unemployed or underemployed definitions, and report 1 or more episodes of unemployment (unemployed and looking for work for at least 1 month) in the past 5 years.

**Securely employed** – adults ages 18-64 who are currently employed and do not meet the definitions of underemployed or problem employed.
