# Selected Findings on 2006 State of the Union Address and Health Care

February 2006

### **Methodology**


The Kaiser Family Foundation *Health Poll Report Survey* was conducted and analyzed by researchers at the Kaiser Family Foundation. A nationally representative sample of 1,203 adults ages 18 and older was contacted by telephone by Princeton Survey Research Associates International between February 2 and February 7, 2006. Interviews were conducted in English and Spanish.

The margin of sampling error for the survey is plus or minus 3 percentage points for total respondents. For results based on smaller subsets of respondents the margin of sampling error is higher. Note that sampling error is only one of many potential sources of error in this or any other public opinion poll.

Did you watch or listen to George W. Bush's recent State of the Union address?




## **State of the Union – President's Emphasis on Health Care**


# **State of the Union – Specific Health Care Topics**

When the President talked about health care, did he emphasize each of the following, or not?





### Awareness and Knowledge of Health Savings Accounts




# **Knowledge About HIV/AIDS and African Americans**

# State of the Union – Specific HIV/AIDS Initiatives


Did the President propose each of the following in his State of the Union address to address the HIV epidemic in the US?
