## Methodology

This Kaiser Family Foundation and seventeen magazine National Survey of Teens: Gender Roles is a random-sample survey of 512 teens, ages 15-17. The survey was designed by the Foundation and seventeen and conducted by telephone by International Communications Research (ICR) between September 5-10, 2002 as part of their monthly teen Omnibus survey. The margin of error is plus or minus $5 \%$ for the total sample and may be larger for certain subsets presented in this analysis.
