** "Physicians, Other Practitioners" includes physicians, lab, x-ray, other practitioners, nurse practitioners, dental and nurse midwife services.

"ICF-MR" stands for intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded.

"Mental Health Facilities" includes inpatient psychiatric services for individuals age 21 and under, and mental health facility services for people age 65 or older.

"Managed Care" includes HMO PHP and PCCM.

"Home and Personal Care" includes home health, personal care, targeted case management, HCBS, and private duty nursing.

"Other" includes other care, transportation, abortion, sterilization, rehabilitation, therapies, hospice, and religious non-medical.
