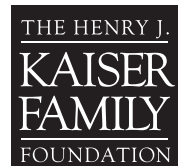
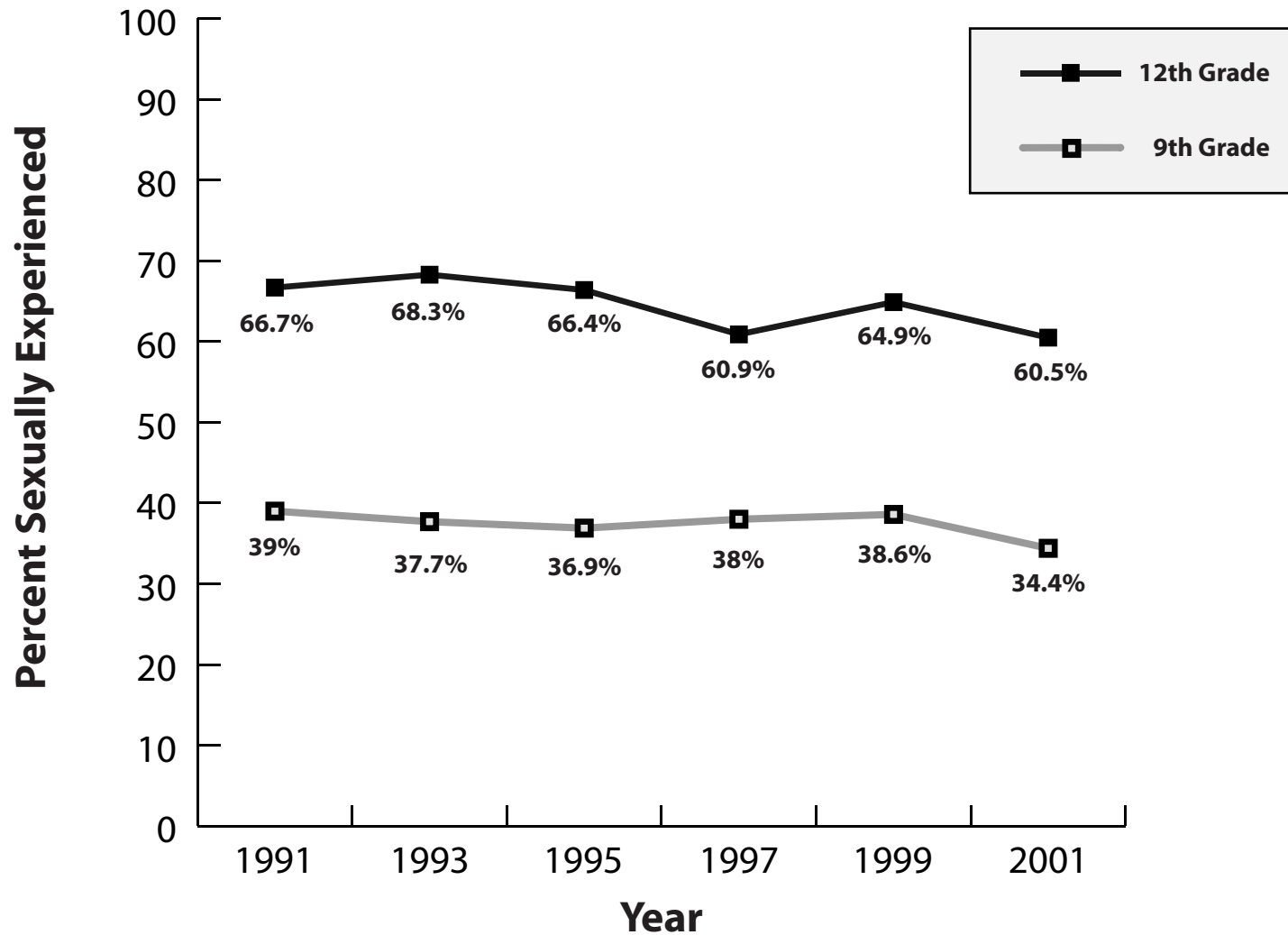


CHART 1

Percent of 9th and 12th grade students who have had sexual intercourse, 1991-2001

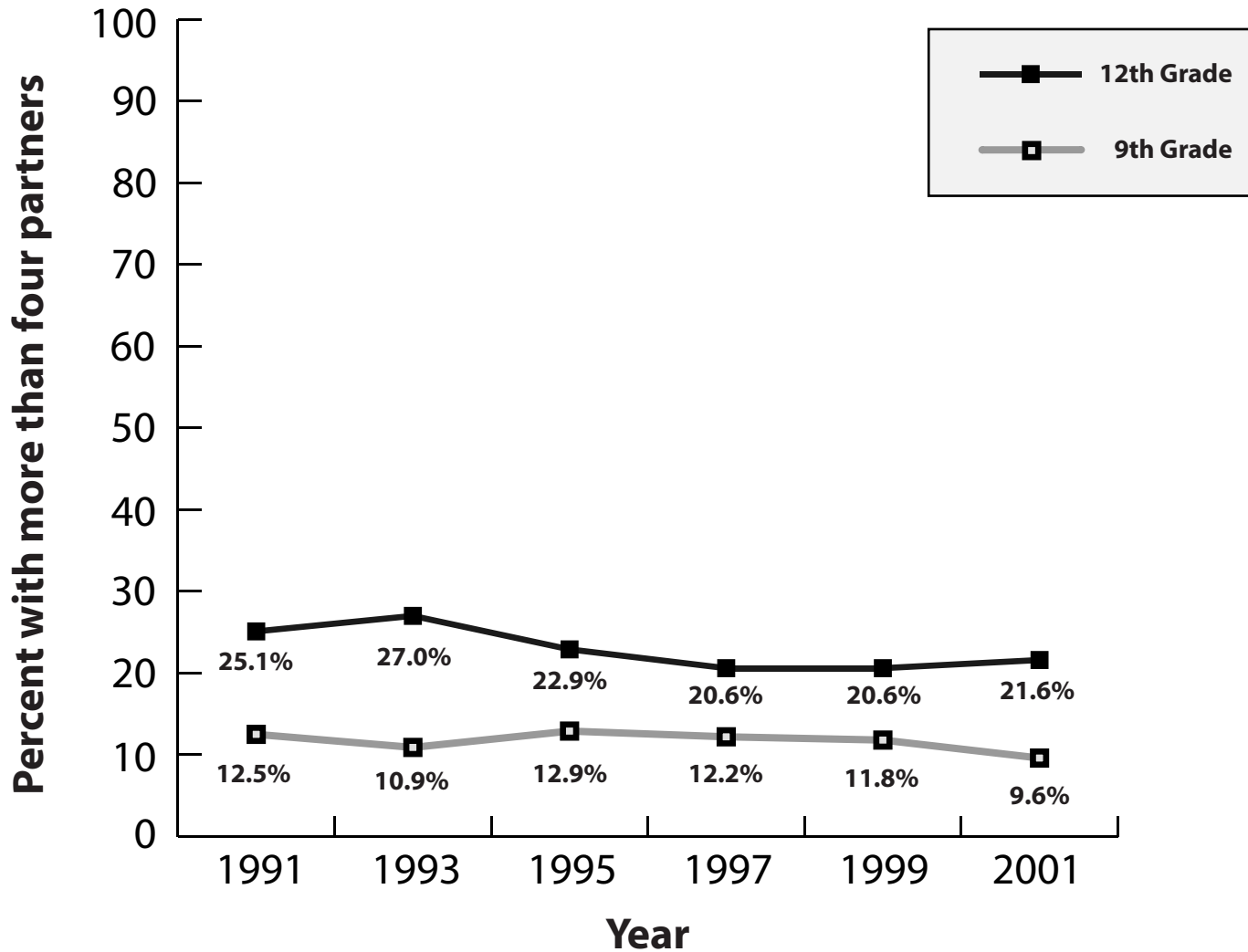

Percent of 9th and 12th grade students who have had sexual intercourse with four or more partners, 1991-2001

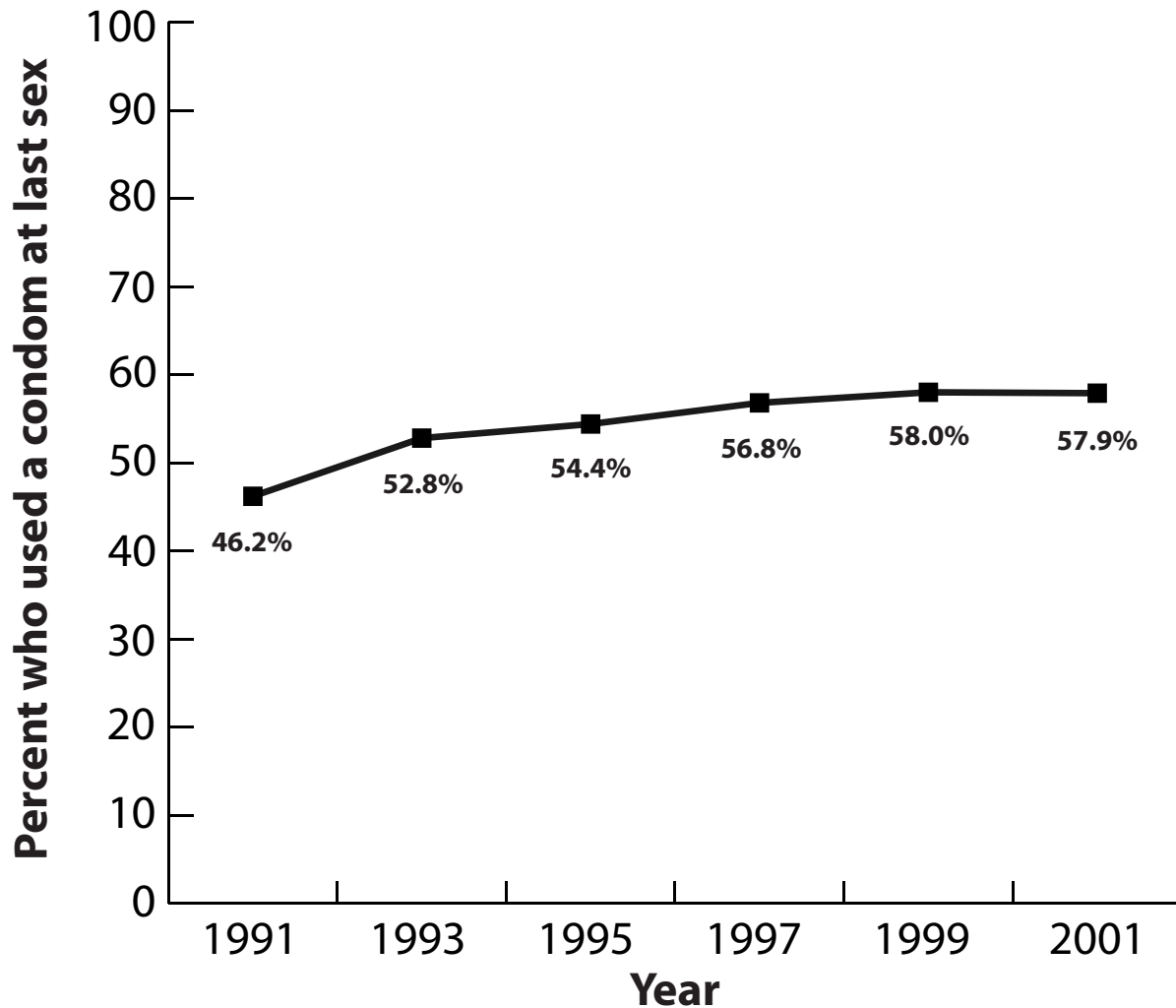

Percent of 9th through 12th grade students who used a condom during the last sexual intercourse, among those who had sexual intercourse during the past three months, 1991-2001

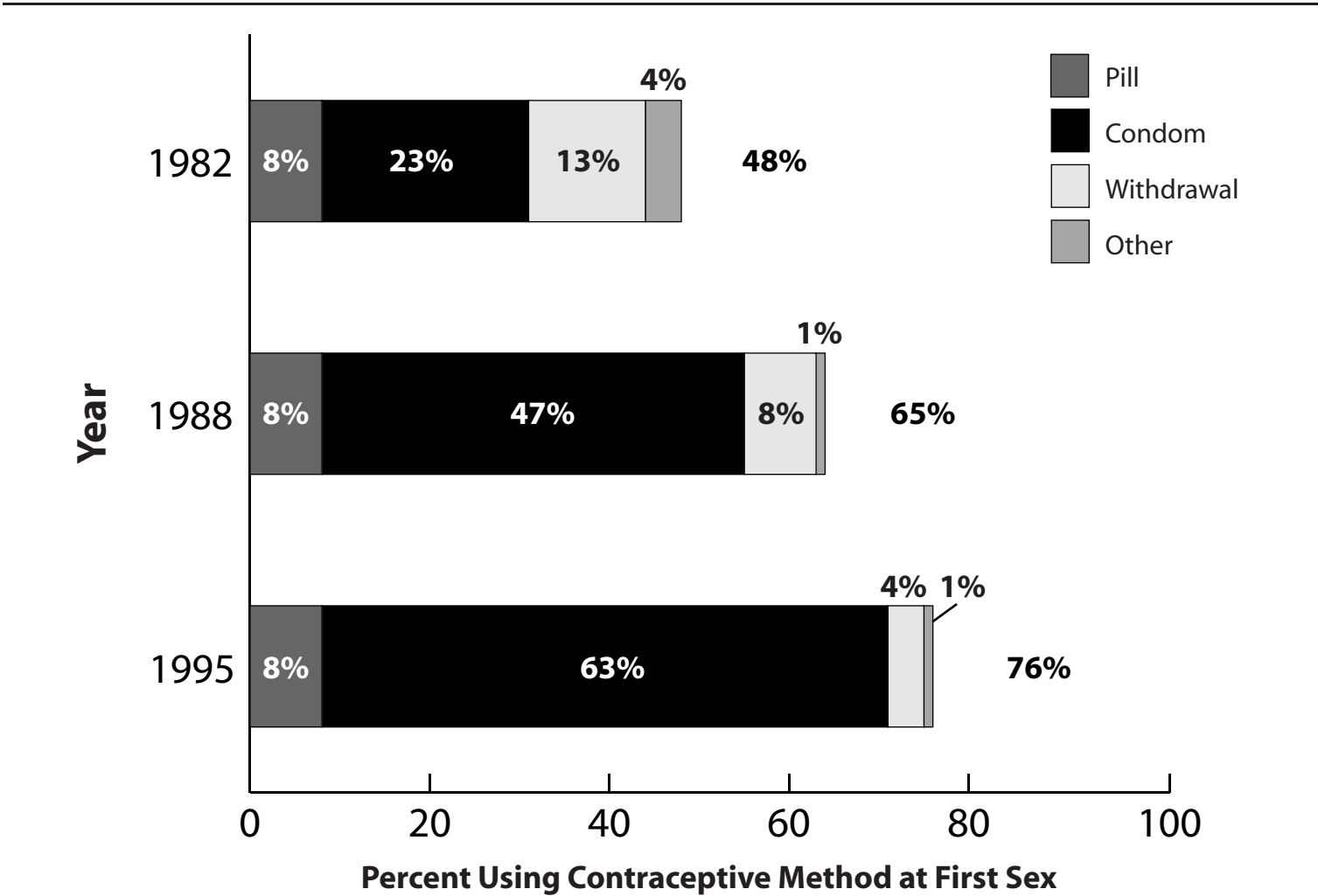

Contraceptive use at first sex among females ages 15-19

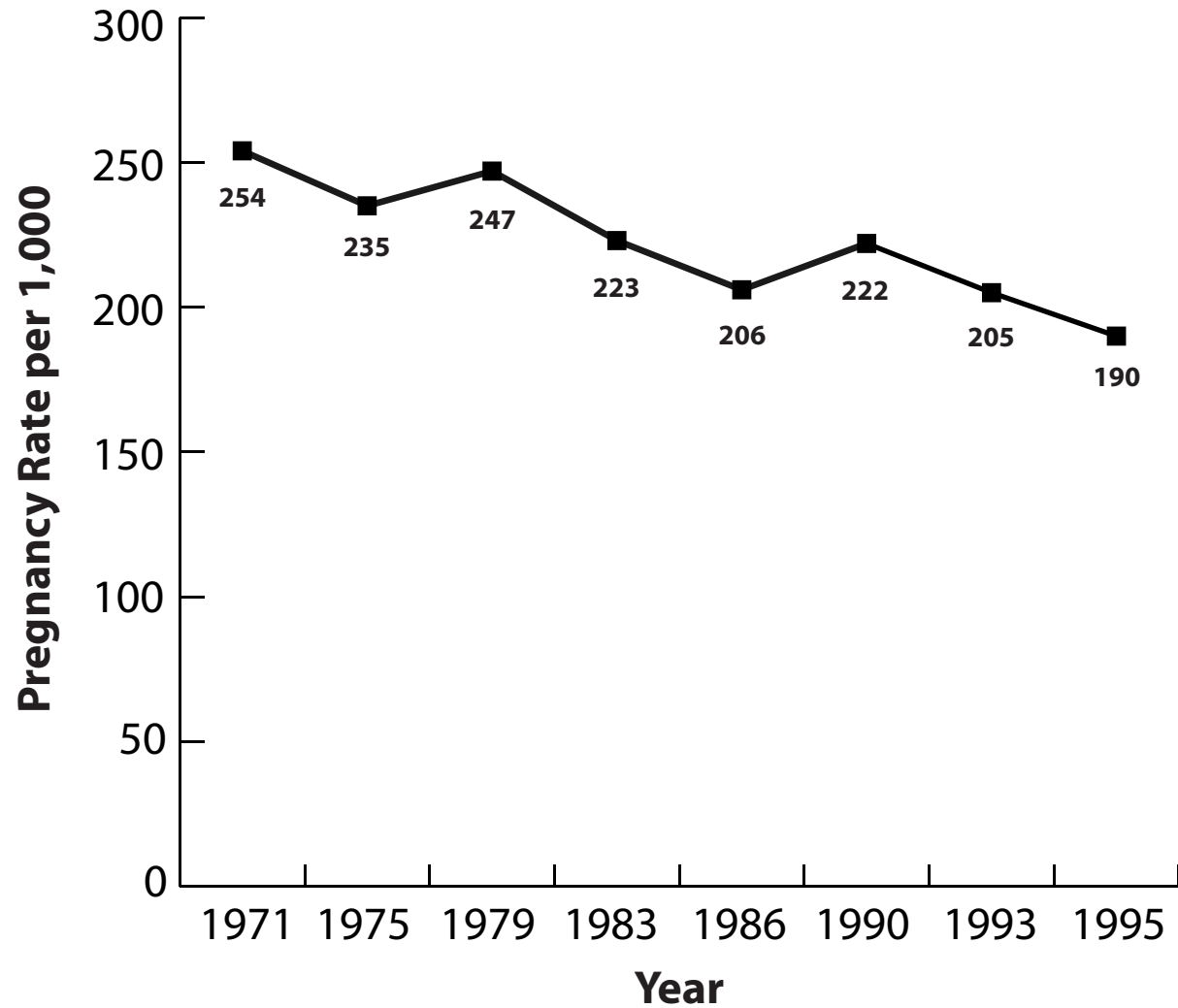
