

Why Track Resources?

The Utility of Resource Tracking Efforts

- To guide policy making and advocacy efforts
 - With major donors (bilateral and multilateral)
 - For recipient countries and affected communities
- To measure against global needs and targets
- To track trends over time – are commitments growing?
- To assess “fair share” (comparisons of giving versus relative wealth)



Why Track Resources? (Continued)

- To help prioritize allocation of limited dollars by donors and recipients
- To assess “additionality”
- To assess burden on affected countries, families, individuals (e.g., how much are they paying vs. major donors?)
- To compare commitments against disbursements
- To measure disbursement rates over time
