

The 2018 Open Enrollment Period runs from November 1 – December 15, 2017 in Florida. Heading into the fifth open enrollment period, coverage remains available through the Marketplaces, along with premium and cost sharing subsidies to make that coverage more affordable. Coverage is available throughout the year through Medicaid, although Florida did not adopt the Medicaid expansion.

ACA Health Insurance Marketplace

In 2017, over 1.4 million people were enrolled in Marketplace coverage.

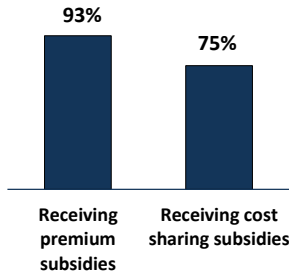

Did FL expand Medicaid through the ACA?

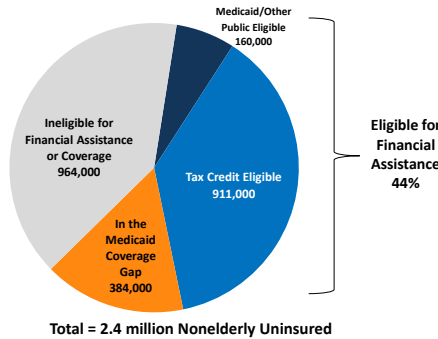

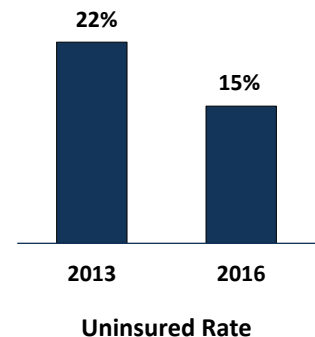


Almost half of the uninsured are eligible for coverage with financial assistance



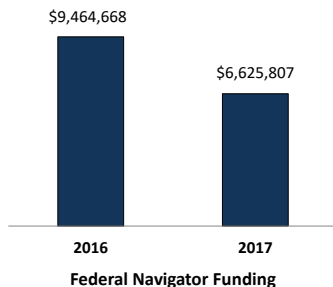
