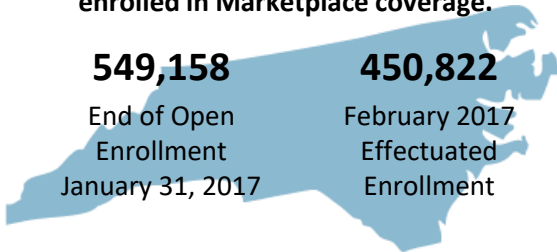


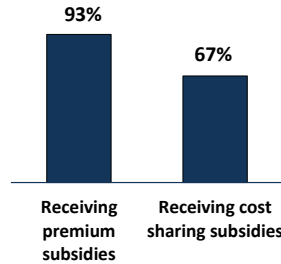
The 2018 Open Enrollment Period runs from November 1 – December 15, 2017 in North Carolina. Heading into the fifth open enrollment period, coverage remains available through the Marketplaces, along with premium and cost sharing subsidies to make that coverage more affordable. Coverage is available throughout the year through Medicaid, although North Carolina did not adopt the Medicaid expansion.

ACA Health Insurance Marketplace

In 2017, over 450 thousand people were enrolled in Marketplace coverage.

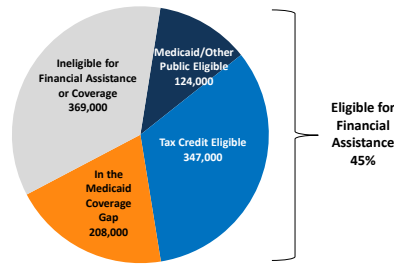

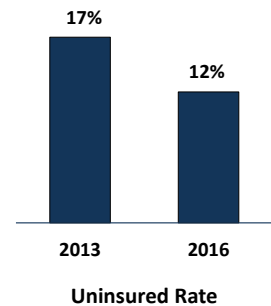

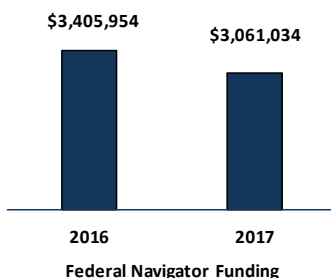
