

The 2018 Open Enrollment Period runs from November 1 – December 15, 2017 in Pennsylvania. Heading into the fifth open enrollment period, coverage remains available through the Marketplaces, along with premium and cost sharing subsidies to make that coverage more affordable. Coverage is available throughout the year through Medicaid.

ACA Health Insurance Marketplaces

In 2017, over 363 thousand people were enrolled in Marketplace coverage.

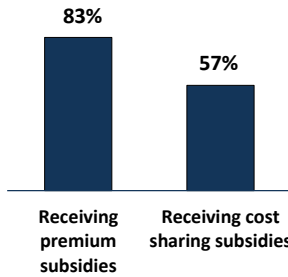

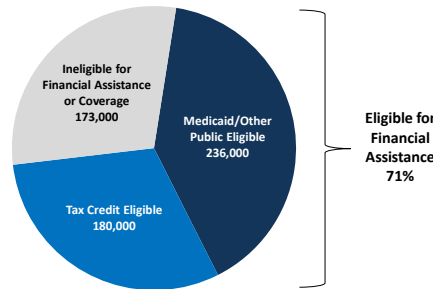
Did PA expand Medicaid through the ACA?

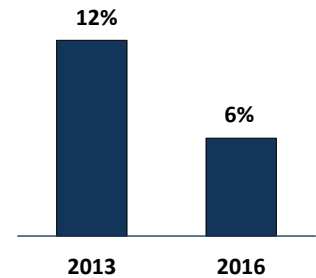
More than two-thirds of uninsured are eligible for coverage with financial assistance

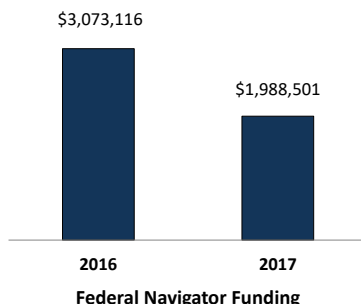
The uninsured rate in Pennsylvania has decreased.
