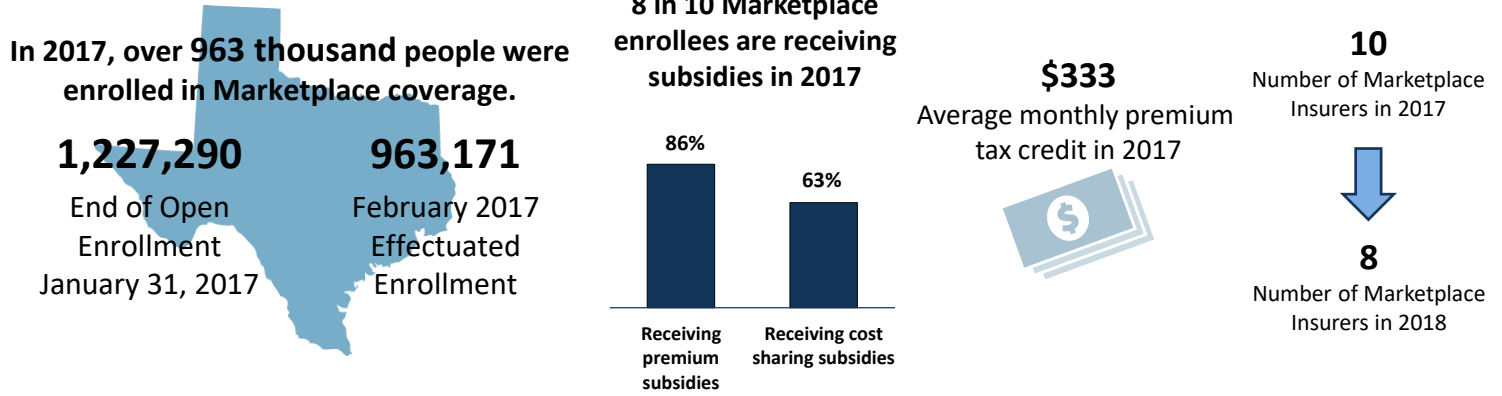


The 2018 Open Enrollment Period runs from November 1 – December 15, 2017 in Texas. Heading into the fifth open enrollment period, coverage remains available through the Marketplaces, along with premium and cost sharing subsidies to make that coverage more affordable. Coverage is available throughout the year through Medicaid, although Texas did not adopt the Medicaid expansion.

Medicaid and the Uninsured

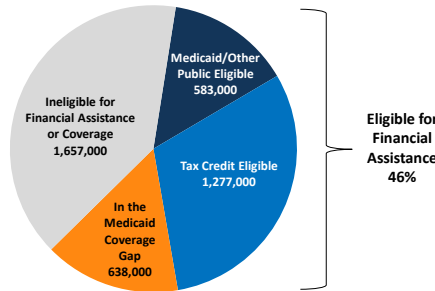
Did TX expand Medicaid through the ACA?

638,000 adults Are in the Medicaid Coverage Gap in FY 2016

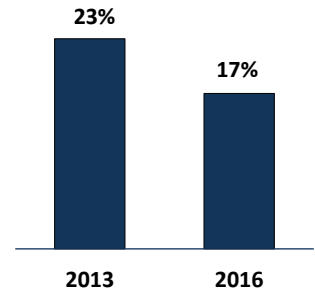


Almost half of uninsured are eligible for coverage with financial assistance

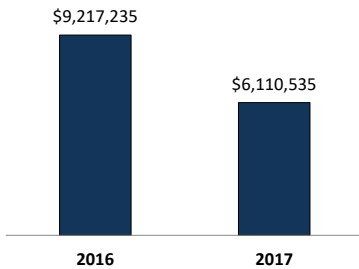
The uninsured rate in Texas has decreased.
