

The 2018 Open Enrollment Period runs from November 1 – December 15, 2017 in Wisconsin. Heading into the fifth open enrollment period, coverage remains available through the Marketplaces, along with premium and cost sharing subsidies to make that coverage more affordable. Coverage is available throughout the year through Medicaid.

ACA Health Insurance Marketplaces

In 2017, over 216 thousand people were enrolled in Marketplace coverage.



Medicaid and the Uninsured


Did WI expand Medicaid through the ACA?

Although WI did not expand Medicaid, there are 0 adults in the Medicaid coverage gap




More than two-thirds of the uninsured are eligible for coverage with financial assistance


The uninsured rate in Wisconsin has decreased.
