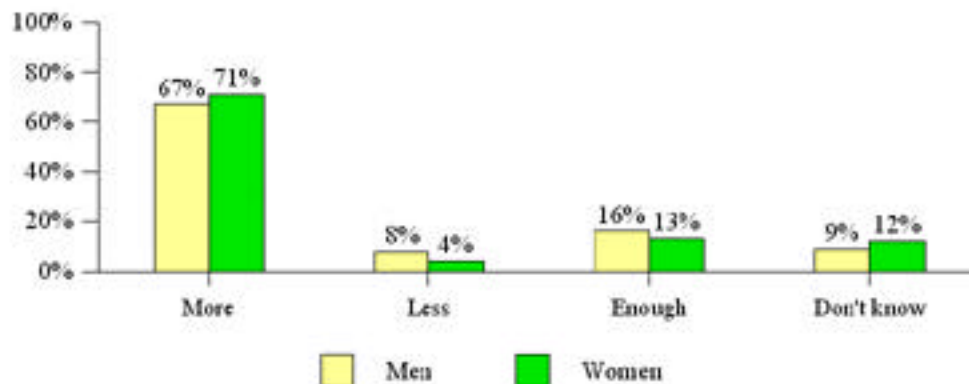

Percent who think most men need to play more of a role, less of a role, or play enough of a role in CHOOSING a method of contraception

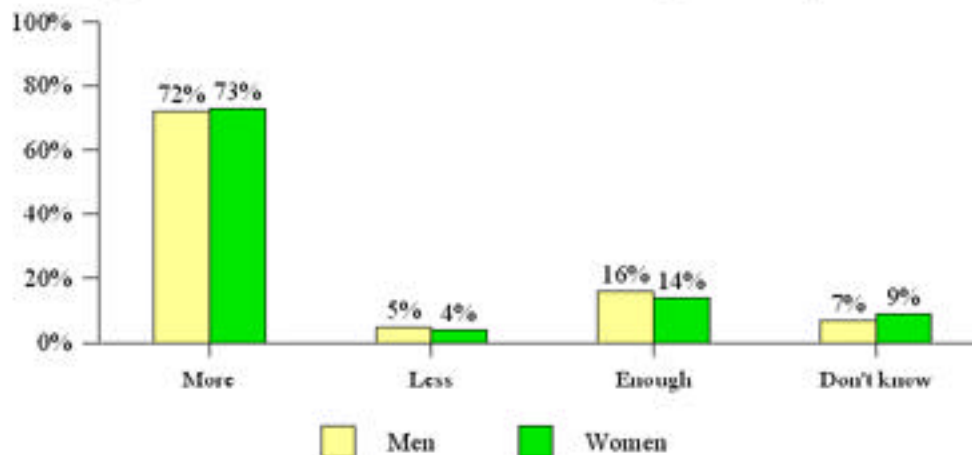

Percent who think most men need to play more of a role, less of a role, or play enough of a role in MAKING SURE contraception always is USED

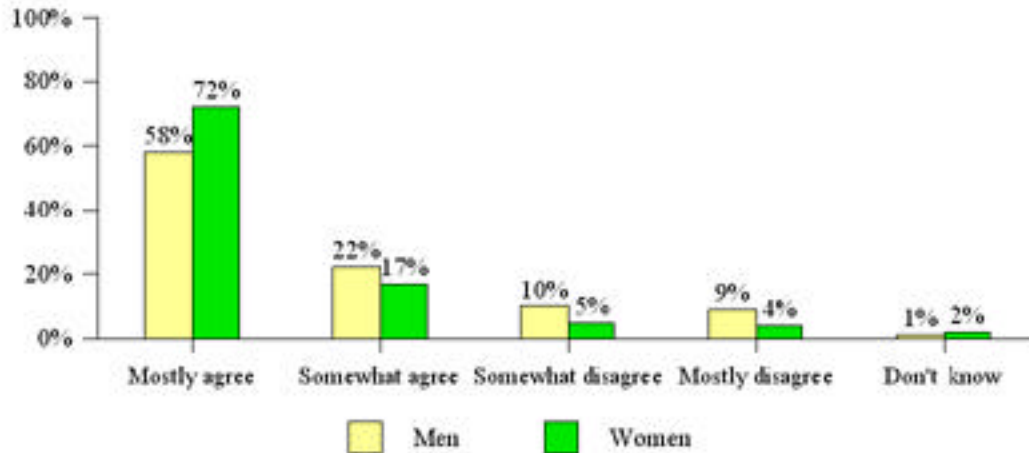

Percent who agree that "women feel more responsibility for the children they bear than most men do"

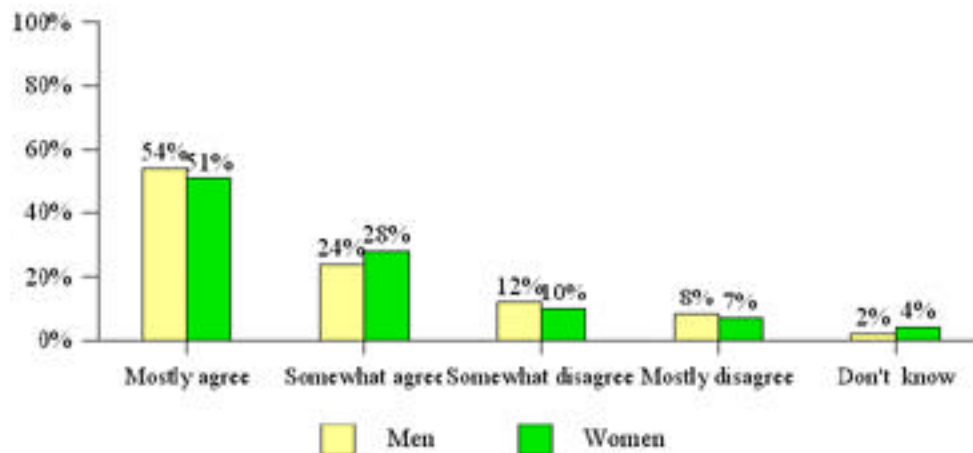

Percent who agree that "women have the biggest influence on when a couple decides to have a child"

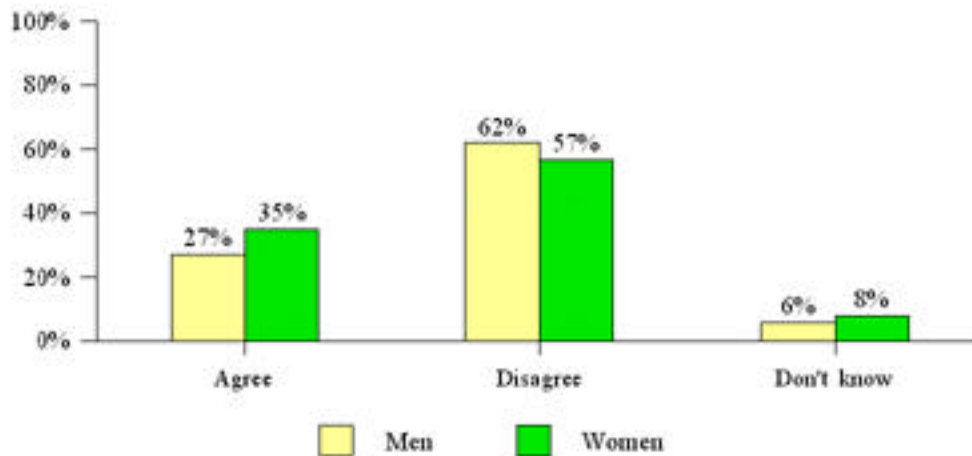

Percent who agree that “men feel left out when it comes to using birth control and preventing pregnancy”

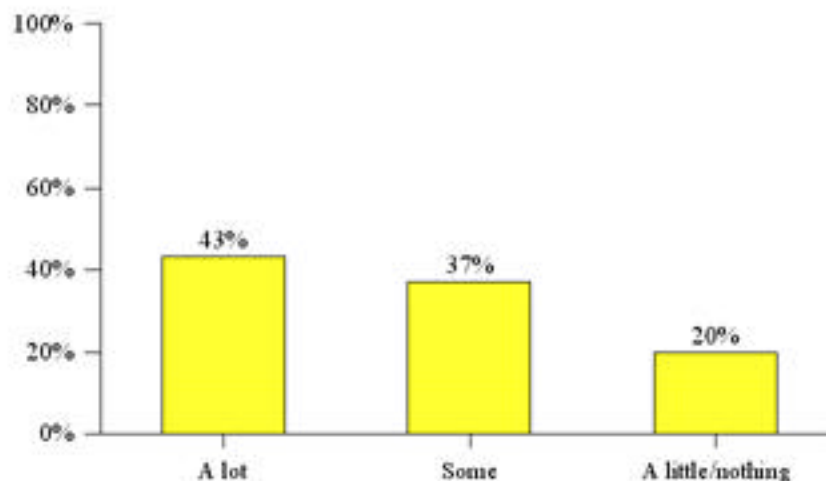

Percent of men who say they know a lot, some, a little, or nothing about the different types of contraceptive options available to couples

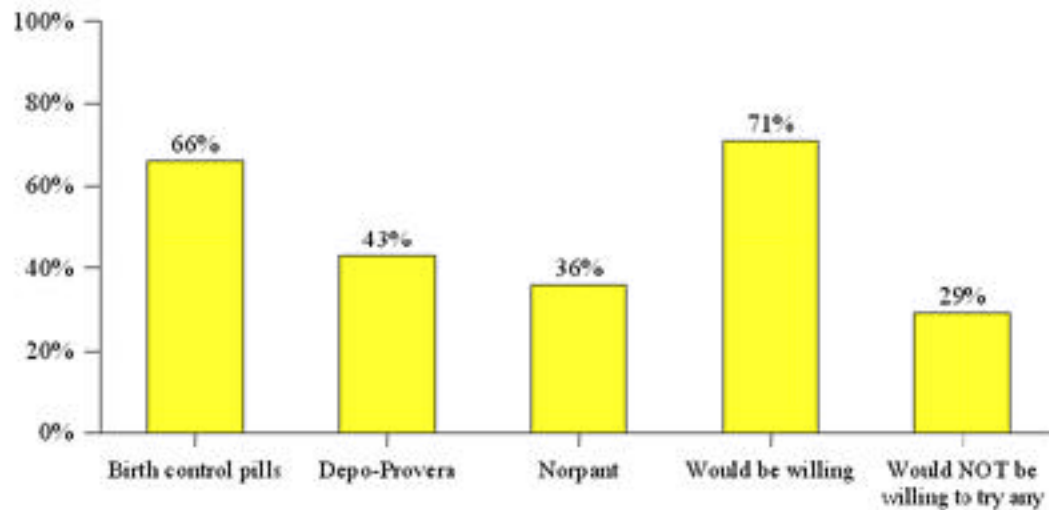

Percent of men willing to consider hormonal contraceptives, if available for men

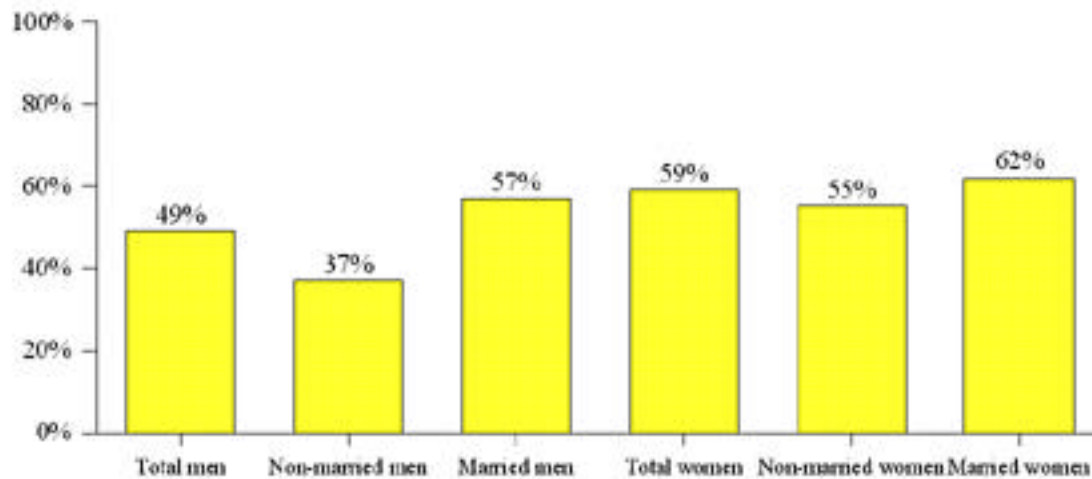

Percent who say they would consider sterilization

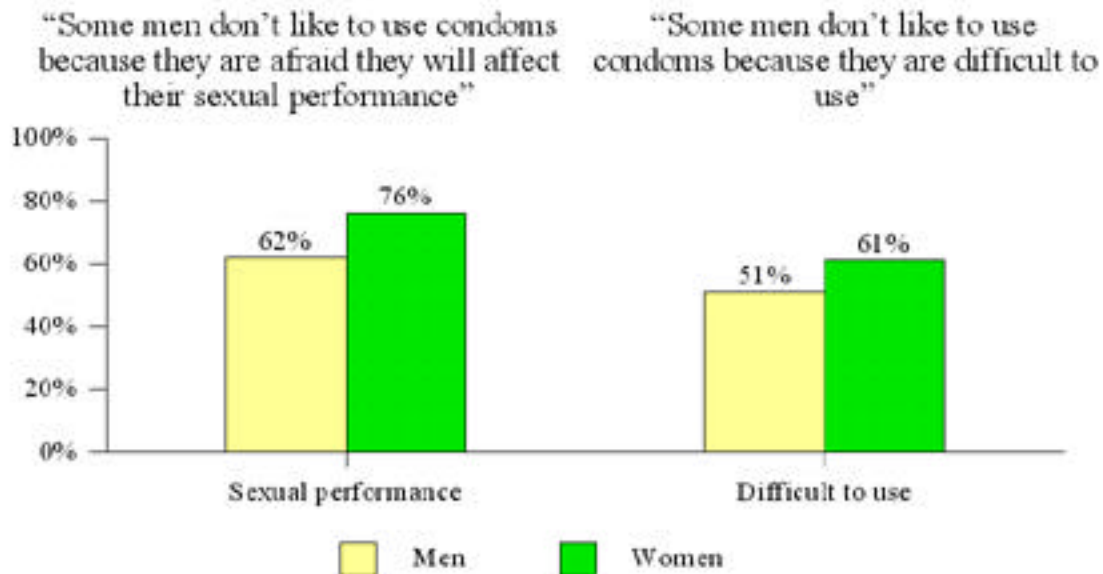
