




## 39 states contract with comprehensive Medicaid MCOs – 19 provide MCO enrollment data on their websites.



### In most states that report their Medicaid MCO enrollment, at least 50% of beneficiaries are in MCOs.



## Payments to comprehensive MCOs account for more than one-quarter of total national Medicaid spending.




Note: Excludes administrative spending, adjustments, and payments to the territories.

## Local and national MCOs both play a large role in the Medicaid managed care market.





## The Medicaid Managed Care Market Tracker can be used for a multitude of descriptive and analytic purposes.

- **State-level data:** Find out about Medicaid managed care in a particular state or states, compare or rank states on selected measures, and get a national overview of Medicaid managed care.
- MCO-level data: Identify Medicaid MCOs, ascertain their current Medicaid enrollment, quality performance, and ownership by multi-state parent firms, and link to key information about their parent firms.
- **Firm-level data:** Learn what other insurance markets parent firms are in, link to financial information about the firms, and find out which parent firms own Medicaid MCOs that have been sanctioned by states.



### **Enhancements to the Tracker are planned.**

- We will add MCO enrollment data for other states as states make the information available.
- We will update data in the Tracker at regular intervals, and trend analysis will become possible over time.
- We will add more indicators as we identify new data sources.
- Watch for new functionality.



#### ABOUT THIS DATA COLLECTION

This Data Collection, the Medicaid Managed Care Market Tracker, provides information related to risk-based Medicaid managed care organizations (MCOs) that provide comprehensive services, including acute care services and, in some cases, long-term services and supports as well, to Medicaid beneficiaries. In addition, the Tracker provides information on parent firms that own Medicaid MCOs in two or more states. Data on other forms of Medicaid managed care, including Primary Care Case Management (PCCM) programs, limited benefit plans, prepaid ambulatory health plans (PAHPs) and prepaid inpatient health plans (PIHPs), and Programs of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE), are not reflected in this Data Collection. For more information on those managed care programs, please see other Medicaid Managed Care data on State Health Facts.

The data in this collection derive from numerous sources, including publicly available data from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and analyses based on them; data reported on the websites of state Medicaid agencies, MCOs, and parent firms; proprietary data (by permission); and other sources. Additional detail on the sources for each indicator is provided below:
